- Sophie Francis-Cansfield quoted in Cosmopolitan The government is launching a review of the porn industry here's what that means "At present, there is a prevalence of harmful pornographic content online from content that sexualises children, through to pornography that depicts incest or sexual violence, normalising online what should, and must be, completely unacceptable," said Francis-Cansfield. She continued: "We are concerned about the societal impacts that this sort of extreme and harmful content can have. The viewing and prevalence of such harmful pornographic content can play a dangerous role in perpetuating gender inequality, and normalising violence towards women and girls, abusive sexual behaviours and domestic abuse. "It is vital that any new legislation on pornographic material drives progress towards a consent-based culture and requires online platforms to be transparent and proactive in preventing and tackling online violence against women and girls."

Magazine MAFS Matt: 'I couldn't comprehend Brad's behaviour towards Shona' Teresa Parker, head of media at the charity, telling The Tab , "It is really important that the experts on the show called this out as controlling behaviour and challenged Brad's view that it was acceptable to say that he had the right to 'allow' Shona to be angry. "TV programmes like these, which are based on the formation of relationships, need to be aware of the dynamics of controlling and coercive behaviour, and always send a clear message that it is wholly unacceptable."
