- **Women's Aid quoted in the Sun** - [Fury as rapper Slowthai put forward for three Brit Awards while facing charges of rape](#) - Women's Aid said organisers should "think carefully" about how nominating Slowthai will feel to rape and sex assault survivors. A spokeswoman said: "For many survivors of abuse, his inclusion on the list will already be a sign that rape is not taken seriously. "With the awards before the court date, organisers should consider that if this man wins a category, how women who have survived rape will feel watching an alleged rapist being celebrated in such a public way."
