- Sophie Francis-Cansfield quoted in the Metro - Reeva Steenkamp was more than just a tragic name in the Oscar Pistorius show - Sophie Francis-Cansfield, head of external affairs at Women's Aid, said murders that occur 'in the home' – such as that of Reeva's – are still not being taken seriously enough, with sentences often too short and not reflecting the severity of the crime. She added: 'It is essential that Reeva Steenkamp is not forgotten and doesn't become a footnote in the story of her killer. 'Each victim of domestic homicide is important – they are daughters, sisters, wives, mothers, beloved friends. 'It is vital that we continue to keep their lives and stories front and centre, as we continue to build a world where violence against women and girls is no longer tolerated.'
