- Women's Aid welcomes £2 million fund to help survivors of domestic abuse
 Our work in the news
 - New flee fund announced in the Sun (print) and Sky News Domestic abuse victims to receive 'flee funds' to escape abusive partners The new scheme funded by the Home Office and delivered by Women's Aid charities, will see these "flee funds" rolled out across England and Wales, and offers an additional £2,500 payment to pay for a rental deposit or bills. Farah Nazeer, Chief Executive of Women's Aid, said: "When we worked on the pilot of the fund in May last year, we saw immediately the impact this was having on survivors over 75% of applicants used their grant to replace or purchase essential goods for themselves or their children, after they had fled their abuser with nothing to their name."
